ATTENTION JUNIORS & SENIORS: ARE YOU A RAZE ACTIVIST? TELL US MORE AND YOU COULD BE AWARDED A RAZE SCHOLARSHIP.

RAZE is awarding scholarships recognizing outstanding activism, participation and leadership in tobacco prevention for the state of West Virginia. RAZE will award three tobacco prevention and cessation champions each with a \$3,000 scholarship. RAZE seniors and juniors are invited to submit a video of themselves explaining how they have contributed to the RAZE movement.



READY TO APPLY? HERE'S WHAT YOU DO.

1. Record a video (five minutes or less) of yourself answering this question:
How you have contributed to the RAZE movement?
2. Sign into the RAZE website using your username and password.
3. Select the Scholarship tab on the left-hand side.
4. Follow the directions and submit your video application.
5. Submit your video application for review before 11:59 PM on **Thursday, May 31**.

Applications are judged on the following criteria. 1) Effort and impact of actions contributing to the tobacco free movement. This could be in your family, on a peer-to-peer level, in your local community or on a state level. 2) Quality (professionalism, clarity and creativity) of the video application. 3) Participation in RAZE including the number of years served as a member and events attended. The RAZE Scholarship application is only open to RAZE members who are seniors or juniors during the 2017-18 school year. By submitting a video, the applicant agrees to give RAZE permission to use the video in whole or in part for future promotional and communication efforts.
